



Dangers of violently destroying a beam splitter

Think we all do a bit of learning "the hard way" - glad you weren't injured. Me and a friend were pushing over a large branch that was hung up on a tree at a steep angle.

Towing the log splitter at speeds higher than 45 mph could result in loss of control, damage to the equipment, or serious injury or death. Adjust towing speed for terrain and conditions.

Never attempt to split wood across the grain as some types of wood may burst or eject from the machine. Never attempt to load the log splitter while the wedge is in motion. Always wear ...

Never store the log splitter indoors next to appliances where there is a source of heat or open flame, spark or pilot light because they can ignite gasoline vapors.

Log Splitter Safety Instructions and understand these instructions before using this equ

If your splitter isn't level, the wedge will not be able to penetrate the log evenly and can put undue stress on the engine, cause the log to split unevenly, or even cause it to bind up.

The safety warnings do not by themselves eliminate any danger. The instructions or warnings they give are not substitutes for proper accident prevention measures. DANGER DANGER indicates a ...

Failure to properly operate and maintain the log splitter could result in serious injury to the operator or bystanders. Operation Warnings Do not at any time carry passengers, sit or stand on the log splitter.

Uneven worksite and unpredictable log movements increase lateral forces on cleaver and may cause slips, injuries or breakdowns. Always align with the axis of the wedge; avoid lateral loads. For ...

Shut off the engine when the log splitter is left unattended, regardless of the length of time. Always load and position the log with your hands on the side of the log. Never position with your hands on the ...

At the beginning, many people make the basic mistake of trying to split logs horizontally, in a position in which, due to the enormous forces, we can damage individual elements of the splitter such as ...
