

How to set up an adjustable attenuator

An attenuator is an easy build and is super useful for getting the most out of your tube amp, especially when playing at home.

In this project, we will go over how to build a very simple attenuator circuit using nothing but a potentiometer.

I have built an attenuator into my amplifier cabs (a Vox AC4C1 and a 5e3 Deluxe clone I made). I've made a simple attenuator out of a bypass switch and a L-Pad (16 Ohms, 50W for the Vox ...

If the attenuator does not have selectable impedance, then you can use any selection on your amp and just go with what sounds best to you. On our attenuators that have two (or three) knobs for adjusting ...

A question that pops up frequently is that of building attenuator pads. Here is what you need to know, in one place.

If you have a head/cab set-up all you do not need to alter your amp. If you're using the attenuator with a combo, you need to have some way to connect the amp output to the attenuator and the attenuator ...
