Push the switch into the OFF position to shut off your home's power. Before you start working, make sure all of the lights in your home are off and test several outlets with a non-contact ...

Open the panel and look for a switch that's halfway between ON and OFF. Flip it fully to OFF. Then flip it back to ON to restore power.
