Imported server racks with high-density cold aisle

In this layout, server racks are arranged in alternating rows, with the fronts of servers facing each other (Cold Aisles) and the backs facing each other (Hot Aisles).

Cold aisle containment focuses on enclosing the cold aisles where cool air is supplied to the front of server racks, to prevent it from mixing with hot exhaust air.
