



Precautions for Acceptance of Optical Delivery Boxes

Use only optical transceivers that are qualified by IBM and comply with the FDA Class 1 radiation performance requirements defined in 21 CFR Subchapter I, and with IEC 825 and EN60825. Optical ...

The box can be opened in front or back and forth. There is enough fiber distribution and storage space in the box, and there are enough winding discs and hanging hooks to facilitate user...

Wear safety glasses with side shields to protect the eyes from errant pieces of fiber. Note: safety glasses will not protect the retina from light damage. Do not touch your eyes or face at any time while ...
