



Requirements for Folded Edges of Distribution Boxes

For self-mailers, we fold together one or more unbound sheets of paper to form a letter-sized mailer. According to the USPS mailing requirements, you have a standard range of dimensions for all your ...

For folded self-mailers, the fold must be on the bottom or leading edge of the piece. For tri-folded self-mailers, the delivery address must be on the middle folded panel.

Many commercial mailers find it helpful to reference these standards as they prepare and enter mailings. For household mailers who need information about retail products and services, the Postal Service ...

If there is a bound or folded edge, the address as read must be within the top half when the bound or folded edge is to the right. It cannot be upside down as read in relation to the top edge. If the address ...

Definition: A post office box module is 2 feet wide and may contain the following boxes based on local needs: 12 number one boxes, 8 number two boxes, 4 number three boxes, 2 number four boxes, or 1 ...

Mailboxes shall be set with the bottom of the box between 42" and 48" above the mail stop surface, unless the U.S. Postal Service establishes other height restrictions.
