



Requirements for overhead cable trays crossing highways

Open high-voltage conductors shall be substantially supported independently of buildings or structures and shall have a clearance from buildings or structures as follows: (1) They shall be ...

All conductors of outside wiring shall comply with clearances specified in Rule 37, General Order No. 95, 1981 Edition, Rules for Overhead Electric Line Construction of the California Public Utilities ...

The illustrations, in Appendix G, of certain requirements are typical and explanatory of some of the minimum requirements set forth in the rules.

As with any electrical equipment, cable trays and the wiring contained in the trays must be listed, labeled or otherwise approved, pursuant to the requirements of 29 CFR 1910.303(a).
