Horizontal lines go left and right. Vertical lines go up and down. Parallel lines are a fixed distance apart and will never meet, no matter how long they are extended.

On the other hand, the NEMA standard mounting position is referred to as F1, with the junction/conduit box located on the left side of the motor facing the output shaft.

Vertical describes something that rises straight up from a horizontal line or plane. A telephone pole or a tree can usually be described as vertical in relation to the ground.

Conductor damage during installation is one consequence of undersizing junction and pull boxes. This damage is often not apparent until post-installation cable testing.

The word vertical is derived from the late Latin verticalis, which is from the same root as vertex, meaning "highest point" or more literally the "turning point" such as in a whirlpool.
