



What to do if the electrical distribution box is near the front door

If the box will be located in a visible spot, such as in a garage, you can simply cover it with a decorative wooden or vinyl door panel. You should also install faceplates and covers on any exposed switches ...

Safety regulations require a dedicated working space to be maintained directly in front of the electrical panel for the protection of anyone performing service or inspection.
